


## Stetson Cellist To Perform In Fsyo's Spring Concert

Cellist David Bjella will be the guest artist during the Florida Symphony Youth Orchestra's spring [concert](#)  this weekend.

The musical performance will be at 3 p.m. Sunday at First United Methodist Church, 142 E. Jackson St., Orlando.


The FSYO's chamber symphony, conducted by Jonathan May, will perform such pieces as Tchaikovsky's "Capriccio Italien" and Beethoven's Symphony No. 1 in C Major.

The symphonic orchestra's program will include Tchaikovsky's "Variations on a Rococo Theme," Couperin's "Overture and Allegro," and Dvorak's Symphony No. 8 in G Major.

Bjella, the former principal cellist for the Florida Symphony, is an assistant professor of cello at Stetson University.

He also was the assistant principal cellist of the Florida Orchestra in Tampa and professor of cello at the University of Central Florida.

This is the third in a series of concerts by the Florida Symphony Youth Orchestra. A reception will follow the performance.
